A good show forward for the red market saw a very pleasing trade throughout. Cows perhaps marginally easier for lighter, plainer sorts however well meated heavier cows look very well sold, a few more clean on offer were meet with plenty of demand and bulls a decent trade. Top slots hit 255p for sucklers, 272p for heifers, 259p for steers and 236p for bulls and 200p for dairy and an overall market average was returned at a very pleasing 192p.

51 Dairy Cattle - Not enough dairies forward for

the level of demand nevertheless the best hit 200p for a Friesian cow weighing 654kgs to generate £1,308.00 for S.T. Pendlebury Ltd, Lipley. Coming a close second was W.P. Benbow & Sons, Fauls with their Friesian cows weighing 858kgs and 698kgs achieving 197p or £1,690.26 and 196p or £1,368.08 respectively. Top price in the lump was £1,755.60 for a cracking Friesian cow weighing 924kgs from D.&A. Holt, Middlewich who had a further two at £1,578.24 (822kgs) and £1,391.20 (740kgs). D.I. & D. Ellis & Sons, Whittington deserve a mention for their Fleckvieh cow weighing 798kgs achieving £1,556.10 and Mr Jonathan Jackson, Longpools with his Friesian cow weighing 762kgs to gross £1,440.08. Talk ring side would have been about the deadweight "gloom and doom" with certain centres taking twenty pence out of the cattle. What a trade! The monthly show and sale supported by the Western Holstein Club is now establishing itself as the premier event in the region at which to buy quality milkers.

Today's fixture was sponsored by Hooftrimming Ltd and was judged by father and son Peter and Simon Stone who selected two calved heifers from Matthew Weaver, Stone as their champion and reserve champion. The champion was the non-pedigree first prize heifer, a Holstein Friesian cross Brown Swiss which sold for the day's top bid of £3,100. The reserve champion was the pedigree heifer Astonpool Wavelength Partridge which sold for £2,600. Matthew Weaver also sold the second prize non pedigree heifer, another Brown Swiss cross for £2,450.

The second prize pedigree heifer Newmeadow Firecracker Susan from Wyndford Wagyu, Newport sold for £2,400 and the only pedigree cow, the third calver Heathleigh Mardigras Cinderella from Robert Horton, Northwich sold for £2,000. The first prize commercial cow, a third calver made £1,900.

Sixteen cattle made over £2,000, nine in the £1,900's, five in the £1,800's and another twelve over £1,500.

Other heifers over £2,500 included £2,680 Andrew Ball, Sandbach, £2,610 David Rees Farms, Crewe, £2,500 Malcolm T Jones, Oswestry and £2,500 John and Ebs Whittaker, Tabley.
