Seasonal entry forward and considering the downward pressure of deadweight centres wanting to give less a very pleasing trade prevailed. Export spec cattle certainly enlightened the trade with pedigree Blues to 290p and some fantastic suckler types 250p plus also strong black and white cows a real trade also. Interesting times ahead with government trying to put downward pressure on the slaughter industry! Only time will tell where we find trade in coming months. I'm a "glass half full" character not half empty and believe demand will still outstrip supply but that's only the thoughts of a humble auctioneer.

Today's dizzy heights reached 290p or £2,273.60 for sucklers, 262p or £2,103.92 for clean, 220p or £1,489.32 for dairy and 208p or £2,495.26 for bulls. The overall market average returned at 191p.

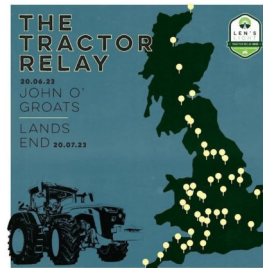
