SUSTAINABLE FARMING INCENTIVE (SFI) EXPANDED OFFER



50+ options previously part of the Mid-Tier Countryside Stewardship (CS) and existing SFI 2023 options have been merged with 20 new options to form the new, Sustainable Farming Incentive (SFI) 2024.

- The new options are to support more sustainable food production, with payments for precision farming and agroforestry.
- Many of the options adopted from the previous, Mid-Tier CS, have been reduced from five year actions to three years to be more accessible to tenant farmers. Of the 102 different actions, 94 will be available for three years.
- Options are set to be fully operational in July and also available for new entrants.

EXAMPLES OF NEW OPTIONS:

- No-till farming: £73 per ha
- Multi-species spring, summer, or autumn cover £153 to £163 per ha
- Camera or remote sensor guided herbicide spraying £43 per ha
