Well, Well, Well, What Can I Say, yet another Record Breaking Sale!! The trade has to be seen to be believed so please come along and experience first hand. Great to see returning faces and hearing the positive comments about the trade and returns, its fantastic to get the positive feed back. Please if you are not back selling live try and adopt the old law of demand and supply and while supply is tight and demand high make the industry compete for your cows, especially with further feeders, exporters and the home trade all looking for cows.

Back to the mesmerising trade resulting in an overall market average of 211p or £1,300.45 and high-lights to 300 pence twice for overage clean or £2,220.00 in the lump, 299p twice for suckler cows or £2,428.80 in the lump, bulls to 282p or £2,185.36 in the lump and dairy's to 256p or £1,969.40 in the lump. Big thank you to both vendors and buyers for their continued support.

107 Dairies - Wow, what a trade with the "bar" being raised again to a new level. Plain lean cows absolute blistering trade and foreign tags also with only a handful of very light plain cows under 1.60p. Certainly not a vintage show with a large contingent of worked and parlour cows in the entry but all keenly contested for. Meated cows raced away to 256p (£1,761.28) from AW.&B. Titterton & Sons, Milwich Heath for their black and white and further cows to 229p (£1,612.16) and 226p (£1,319.84). Feeding types to 248p (£1,607.04) from L.F. Horton & Sons, Little Leigh, Mr Charles Forrester, Northwood saw 229p (£1,515.98) and 251p (£1,385.52), S.R. Lewis & Son, Eyton cow to 239p (£1,735.24), J.W. Cotton & Son, Gratwich to 235p (£1,489.90) and 230p (£1,743.40) and DLG. Morris & Partners, Handley to 229p (£1,969.40) and 220p (£1,751.20) to mention a few. The section average returned at whopping 190p or £1,167.64 in the lump.
