However, I want to give credit where it is due, our vendors have supplied the goods for our buyers to bid at. The trade looks like it is here to stay for now, so if you're after calves get yourself to Market Drayton where there is plenty of choice to ensure you go home with a full trailer.

Onto the section round up starting with the Friesians which remain in short supply, and very short on quality today. Top price was £385... yes that is right, a 6 week old British Friesian made £385 for regular marksman Mr M. Davies, Saughton. Best bulls £170 to £220, mediums £120 to £160, smalls £50 to £100.

The native bulls have been extraordinary, and I think it's fair to say that we haven't had enough best bulls to go around... mediums have been £270 to £320 today, which needs to be seen to be believed. Top spot was £435 for an Angus from P. & R. Robinson, Faddiley. Best types £340 to £400, mediums £270 to £320. Smalls £130 to £180.

The Continental bulls have been an incredible trade with a lot of top quality on offer. 148 bulls averaging £348....20 Simmentals averaging £416!!! Top spot was a stunning Limousin bull from JS. & HJ. Gleave, Audlem at £640! Best at £400 to £470, mediums £320 to £380, smalls at £220 to £290.

The Native heifers continue to see an electric trade with a good variety on offer today. The best heifers would be up another gear with 32 selling for over £280. Top spot going to a Hereford at £365 from Mr M.P. Mason, Wolverhampton. Best types at £250 to £320, mediums at £160 to £240, smalls £70 to £140.

The Continental heifers saw huge demand throughout and were probably dearer than the bulls with 147 heifers averaging £325!! Top price was £480 for a Charolais from H.J. Myatt & Sons, Ellenhall. Best types £360 to £420, mediums £280 to £340, smalls £180 to £260.

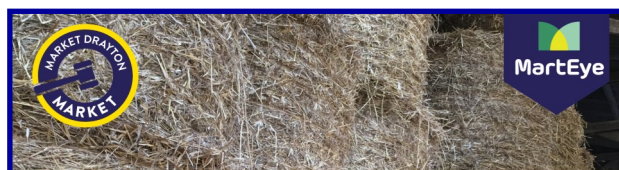
