Cracking number forward and trade remaining extremely buoyant for barren cows and infact in some places cows would be dearer on the week. Certainly no "gloom and doom" evidence of deadweight prices falling ringside with buyers keen for cows on the night!! A big thank you as always to our vendors and buyers for their continued support and trust in Market Drayton Market.

Top of the shop this week returned at 363p or £2,787.84 for sucklers, 346p or £2,934.08 for clean, 342p or £2,641.00 for dairy and 341p or £3,513.60 for bulls. The overall market average returned at 263p or £1,734.89.

110 Dairies - Great to be back over the one hundred mark with several returning faces back supporting and pleased with their trades. A smaller entry as expected with many regular vendors sold up over recent months and the weather possibly holding a few back from selling just yet. The ringside would be quieter than normal however it did not alter the trade with buyers after volume numbers of cattle. Numbers holding extremely well for the time of year with more and more travelling supporters ring side. Trade yes a little easier and inline with national trends as demand at present eased at the "coal face" and a few more cattle coming ready!
