A fantastic day in the calf section with excellent numbers of calves and the surprisingly large entry of weanlings from several homes (A coincidence rather than

being planned). Another super trade with all 641 calves averaging £386 per head! The edge would be slightly off the smaller end of the calves in comparison to recent weeks but the best and mediums still look extremely well sold. Looking ahead, it is worth noting that from next week, England will fall within the restricted Blue Tongue area. While it is clear this will have some impact on our calf trade, the extent of that impact remains uncertain. For now, we continue with the optimism which the recent trade has brought and hope that changes to the situation emerge sooner rather than later. A huge well done to Mike Kulik of Loppington who has taken the crown for the new record calf price at £1220 for a 40 day old Charolais heifer calf today.
