Cracking number forward for a bank holiday Monday and a huge vote of thanks to all our vendors and buyers for supporting. Trade remains extremely buoyant for the time of year and certainly seeing a premium for young feeding types and meat types. The only caveat being light plainer cows which would be a little harder to place and due to the dry weather a larger than normal contingent on the night. August seems to have passed in a blink of an eye and the return of schools and end of the holiday exodus may aid trade going forward. Lets be a glass half full person pushing the trade forward.

The sale saw bulls to 342p or £2,877.16, dairy to 322p or £2,422.72 and sucklers to 319p or £2,398.88. The overall market average returned at 230p or £1,384.52.

130 Dairies - A fantastic number forward and demand throughout with the trade of the day for a young black and whites racing away to 322p or £1,996.40 from PA.JE.&J. A good entry of calves forward for the end of August with trade holding up well overall. Stronger calves were in best demand and led the way, while the mediums were a shade easier, particularly the Continentals, with the Natives holding a bit firmer. The same story ran through the younger and smaller sorts, but they still looked well sold with plenty of interest around the ring. With the forage shortage tightening every day, it wouldn't be a surprise to see the smaller end ease back further in the weeks ahead. All 665 calves averaged £335 per head.

Friesian Bulls – A decent show with good demand too. Top price was £270 from JS.&HJ. Gleave, Audlem. Best: £160-£250, Mediums: £80-£140, Smalls: £40-£70.

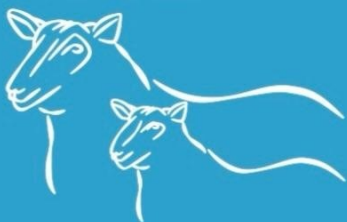
