BRISCOE DAIRY HERD SALE TOPS AT £2,900

Roger Briscoe and his family of Huxley, Chester moved their commercial milking herd to Market Drayton Market for convenience to be dispersed.

The top price was £2,900 for a freshly calved second calver giving 38kgs daily which had recorded 7,992kgs as a heifer.

Third calvers which had been calved two months sold for £2,650 and £2,500 and a June calved second calver made £2,600.

All the milkers averaged £1,511, a very good average considering the large number of older cows and many with various faults.

Trade electric with more buyers ringside and certainly adding value to younger cows on the night, so thank you to all for your support and also big thank you to all the staff as it certainly was a "Mega Monday" with several sales all happening!!!!

The stand out prices on the night returned at 338p or £2,217.70 for overage clean, sucklers to 301p or £2,227.50, bulls to 290p or £2,389.60 and dairy to 290p or £2,259.60. The overall market average returned at 243p or £1,516.24.

127 Dairies - A cracking number forward thank you, selling on a blistering trade throughout especially for young lean cows with potential to feed. A strong entry today, with numbers still looking short nationwide — and what a trade we've seen! With the ongoing fodder shortage, I would encourage vendors to seriously consider marketing stock now, as many were pleasantly surprised by the strength of the trade. An excellent show of quality throughout — well done to all vendors.

Bulls – A good number forward with 39 bulls. A lot of well-fleshed examples which were good to sell with demand from a number of holdings. Top price went to a 7 month Charolais at £1,120 from N&M. Hulme, Frankton with 7 month Limousins close behind at £1,030 from R&K. Jones, Chirbury. Younger models topped at £780 for 5 month Blues from JN&HM. Bennett, Stoke-on-Tern, who also sold 6 month Angus bulls at £700. and £760 for 9 month Friesians from JN&HM Bennett. All bulls averaged £644.96.

Steers - A good show of quality and a fast trade throughout. There has been 102 forward with a good mix of ages to suit all budgets. Leading the way was a 9 month Blue from Mr T.W. Goldstraw, Audlem at £1190. Some 11mo Angus sold to £1140 from Mr M. Groom, Croxton and 10mo Blues to £1060 from Mr M. Latham, Derby. The younger steers topped at £920 for a group of 5-6 month Blues from Miss J.A. Fox, Barthomley with various other vendors selling packets of Blues of the same age for £700-£800. A group of 5month Angus realised £720 for Mr M. Latham, Derby and 4 month Blondes from Matt Groom sold for £690. All steers averaged £712.56.

Heifers – 107 heifers saw a fantastic trade with quality in abundance – all heifers averaged £676.21 per head. Top call went to a 10 month Angus from Mr T.W. Goldstraw, Audlem which sold for £1,000. Next was a 7 month Charolais from Matthew Pinto at £970. A lovely packet of 9 month Blue heifers from HK&SB. Bennett, Woodseaves realised £910 and 8 month Simmentals sold for £880 from Mr M. Latham, Derby. Younger types included 6 month Blues from Miss J.A. Fox, Barthomley at £800 who also sold 5mo Simmentals for £780.

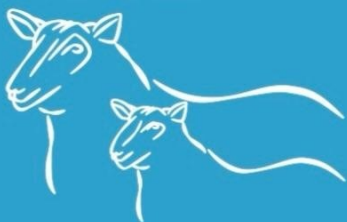
