A fantastic number of cows forward selling on a flying trade from start-to-finish. Reports of deadweight centres dropping the price was not reflected in the live ring with all weights and grades keenly contested for. Not the best show in terms of quality with a lot of small light plain cows nevertheless looking very well sold with feeding cows in very strong demand and meat commanding a premium.

Leading lights shone to 317p for dairies or £2,176.26, 346p or £2,836.68 for sucklers, 298p or £3,190.56 for bulls and 340p or £2,708.64 for overage clean.

**144 Dairies** - The best sold to 317p for a Friesian cow weighing 572kgs to generate £1,813.24 for RJB Farming Ltd, Marbury. Top price in the lump was £2,176.26 for a Friesian cow weighing 874 kilos from R.&J. Madders, Adbaston. Other highlight prices as follows:- Friesian (676kgs) £1,967.16 JS.&HJ. Gleave, Friesian (768kgs) £1,966.08 Millenheath Farm Ltd, Norwegian Red (716kgs) £1,961.84 HR.SL.&OD. Bonell, Friesian (744kgs) £1,919.52 N. Dakin & Sons and Friesian (798kgs) £1,915.20 N. Dakin & Sons to mention a few. Meated cows traded from 260p to 280p, steakers 230p to 260p, heavy plain 210p to 230p and thereafter 180p to 210p. A good entry forward for mid-November but many more could have been sold today! A phenomenal trade and a superb show with plenty of suckler bred models still coming forward. The trade was fast throughout with prices climbing and a lot of confidence ringside which was great to see as we had buyers attend from across England and Wales.

Boston, Rugeley; and 7 month Limousins from N.G. Simpkin, Stone followed at £1,570. Then we had 7 month Blues from OM&JR. Whittingham, Market Drayton at £1,490 and 10 month Blues from Mr M. Latham, Derby at £1,400. Younger types topped at

£1,300 for 5 month Blues from Mr T.W. Goldstraw, Audlem who sold Blues at £1,300; 5 month Herefords sold to £970 from PA&J. Boston and 5 month Blues from J.R. Drinkall Ltd at £860. All steers averaged £1,034.76.

Numbers remaining fairly consistent but a much more mixed entry selling on a two tier trade. Better fleshed and heavier types very easy to place and keen demand throughout. However leaner, plain and colder types harder to place with the only saving grace having six further finishers operating holding the trade and that is the true beauty of Market Drayton. Also we do not just “cherry pick” the best we do have an extremely diverse array of cattle forward from 360 kilos to 890 kilos, P1 to E3 grades and a lot originating from dairy cattle not sucklers but as always we are content with our lot and thank you for your support both ringside and by our vendors.

Taking top honours this week we sold heifers to 468p or £2,637.60, steers to 448p or £2,790.90 and bulls to 437p or £3,757.84. The overall market average returned at 360p or £2,133.56.

**51 Bulls** - A humble number forward selling on a lighter stronger trade especially for bulls with shape and loin. 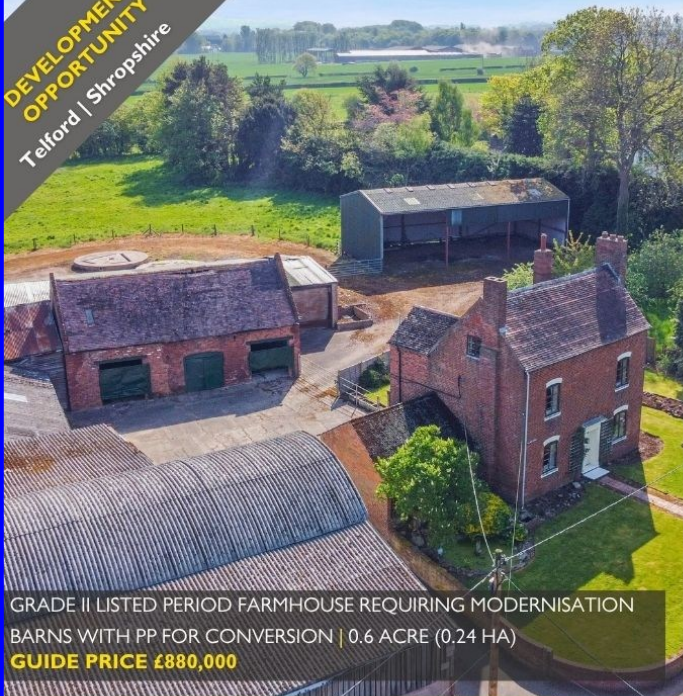
