Please remember younger and leaner types would be better sold on a green if not restricted with the further finisher influence. Trade extremely brisk for the time of year and with an additional buyer ring side certainly helped the trade.

Once again big thank you to all our vendors and buyers for their continued support and please keep the numbers coming to meet growing interest, thank you!!

Highlight of the trade saw bulls to 389p or £2,774.72, clean to 339p or £2,354.76, sucklers to 323p or £2,867.42 and dairy to 284p or £2,420.60. The overall market average returned at 246p or £1,566.19.

123 Dairies - Exceptional number finding a cracking trade topping at 284p or £2,237.92 for a black and white from Mr Jim O'Neill & Family, Moreton Saye trio at 257p (£2,210.20, £1,968.62 and £1,901.80) etc. D.I. Ball & Son, Smallwood cow to 280p (£1,657.80), Mr Charles Forrester, Northwood cow to 270p (£1,906.20), Mr Jonathan Jackson & Family, Longpools cow to 266p to return £2,420.60 etc. S.R. Lewis & Son, Eyton cow to 265p (£1,913.30), Mr S.J. Another good entry forward selling on a two tier trade with good well fleshed and shaped cattle very easily placed and selling on a very brisk trade considering the deadweight "Gloom and Doom" talk of reducing prices. Plainer, lighter types a little bit harder to place but the trade was certainly underpinned with further finishers adding value to these types. On the day we saw a well balanced ring of buyers ensuring a buoyant trade in testing times and dare I say it many more could have been sold to vendors advantage especially with thirteen buyers on twenty-five accounts, showing the live ring certainly offers competition!!

Leading the charge this week to earn top podium finishers with heifers to 458p or £2,633.04, steers to 459p or £2,919.20 and bulls to 434p or £3,298.40. The overall market average returned at 362p or £2,196.73.

51 Bulls - Numbers forward and the trade very similar to last week with heavy, good shaped sucklers certainly commanding a premium selling to 434p or £3,298.40 for Limousin from Mr Edwards Evans & Family, Lane Farm and further bulls to 430p (£3,242.20) and 420p (£2,998.80). Morris & Sons, Llangedwyn Blue Cross to 416p (£2,254.72) and Paul & Christine Tippetts, Lodge Hill to 414p (£2,633.04). Natives to 375p (£2,055.00) for Hereford from Emyr Roberts & Family, Llanfihangel and dairy breeds saw Brown Swiss to 384p (£2,211.84) from Mr Brian Mould & Family, Levedale.
