Red certainly did not mean stop with one of the best entries forward we have seen on a red market for a while and the trade was extremely brisk considering the quality forward. Certainly not a vintage show with a large contingent of parlour and lean cows forward but all selling on a very buoyant trade. Big thank you to all vendors and buyers and its great to see new faces back either selling or buying! Do not forget a red market accommodates not only TB restricted cattle but also there is no "six-day" rule to contend with.

Top calls rang out to 340p or £2,113.56 for sucklers, 328p or £3,161.30 for bulls and 294p or £2,453.76 for clean. The overall market average returned at 244p or £1,569.43.
