2,400 GUINEAS TOP AT CHESTER

BRITISH FRIESIAN SALE

Prices peaked at 2,400gns at the very well attended sale of the Hollinscourt herd of British Friesians for Patrick and Liz Davies held on farm at Saighton, near Chester.

The top price of 2,400gns was for a second calver sired by Deangate Prince which had calved in late January and was purchased by a Carmarthenshire buyer.

The same West Wales buyer gave the second highest price of the day of 2,300gns for another Deangate Prince second calver which had calved in early February.

The fresh milk trade was subdued reflecting the current glut of milk but the Autumn calvers met a very much better trade with October calving second and third calvers selling to 2,100gns twice and 2,000gns.

The trade of the day was for the in-calf heifers with a Scottish buyer taking home a Bradash Patriot Robin Red daughter calving in May at 1,950gns.

The same Scottish buyer paid 2,000gns for another Bradash Patriot Robin Red daughter calving in November.

Another November calving heifer sold for 2,000gns to a Staffordshire buyer.

Humble number forward and that would be the only humble factor on the day as the trade was electric from the first bull to the last cow. Barren prices seem remarkably brisk considering clean cattle prices with plenty of demand ringside for cows and some real spirited and competitive bidding even without the "X" factor of further feeders. Next week is a Green and more cows will be needed to meet increasing demand. All and any support greatly appreciated. Thank you as always to the vendors and buyers who did attend.
