A Bank Holiday Bonanza in the weanling ring with a truly fantastic number and full of show quality cattle! The ring was as packed as we've ever seen and we've had 73 successful purchasers today. This led to a tremendous trade with confidence brimming around the ring from start to finish which resulted in an outstanding overall average of £1010 per head. The youngest continue to look the dearest but all vendors would go home happy with their days trading.
