A light show for the red market met with a very pleasing trade. Perhaps slightly easier than recent weeks as to be expected with report of deadweight centres all dropping the price. Nevertheless top high lights shone to 265p or £1,997.96 for dairies, 319p or £2,341.46 for sucklers, 272p or £1,882.24 for bulls and 335p or £2,338.30 for clean. An overall market average was returned at 251p or £1,601.24.

**57 Dairies** - A lot of light plain cows in the mix still look very well sold and meated cows still in strong demand. The best sold to 265p for a Friesian cow weighing 564kgs to realise £1,494.60 for H.&J. Smith & Sons, Biddulph Moor. More cattle forward and selling to a very similar trade as last week. Best meated and shapely cattle selling well with overage leaner under finished sorts hard to sell. Not enough best cattle in the mix with a lot of out of spec cattle forward would reflect slightly in the overall average which was returned at 331p or £2,022.73. Leading lights hone to 434p or £2,664.76 for heifers, 386p or £2,745.40 for steers and 396p or £3,595.68 for bulls.

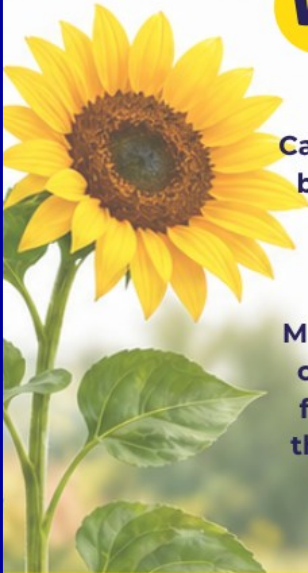

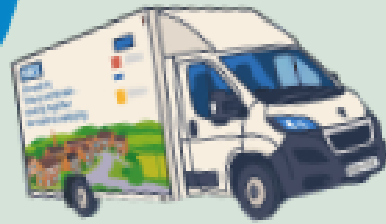

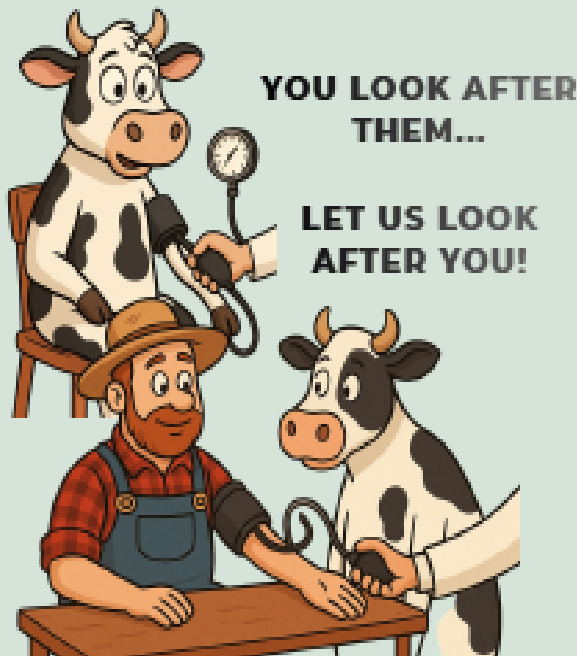
