Reasonable show for the time of year with an entry dominated with mainly lean, parlour cows and light weight cross breeds. Trade remarkably brisk for the time of year and compared to the clean cattle very easy to place. Big thank you as always for vendors and buyer support and please keep the numbers coming to meet demand.

The hot take on the trade with clean to 300p or £2,656.44, sucklers to 300p or £2,231.30, bull to 260p or £2,360.80 and dairy to 260p or £2,002.00. The overall market average returned at 224p or £1,412.83.

56 Dairies - Certainly not a vintage show with a large proportion of lean parlour types forward. Premium still for young meated cows selling to 260p or £2,002.00 for black and white from new faces at Drayton The Edwards Family, Welshpool and further cows to 258p (£1,780.20) and 248p (£1,974.08). Closer to home saw Park House Dairy Ltd, Ashley selling cows to 238p (£1,765.96) etc, N & B. Livestock, Myddle Brown Swiss to 235p (£1,245.50) and Mr Mark Lokier & Family, Newtown black and whites to 232p twice (£1,336.32 and £1,248.16) to mention a few. The section average returned at 199p or £1,145.42.

Massive numbers were forward for the June sale, with no sign of any let-up in demand. Despite fewer buyers ringside, competition remained fierce, resulting in a fast and consistent trade throughout. Grazing cattle attracted the strongest demand, although younger types continued to sell exceptionally well, reflecting the strength of the current calf trade. The £900-£1,000 bracket is now firmly established as the benchmark for the majority of weanlings, with today's overall average of £939 per head further underlining the strength of trade seen across recent sales.

Very short of bulls but quality more than made up for it and competition for the stronger sorts remained high, helping to maintain an excellent trade. Top spot went to a 10 month Limousins at £1,480 from Mr C.J. Nash, Stone; 5 month Blues at £1,160 from Mr T. Charlton, Shrewsbury who also sold 5 month Angus to £1,120; 5-6 month Blues from A.&C. Lloyd, Caersws at £1,010; 7 month Angus at £970 from Mr M. Clarke, Crewe; 4 month Limousins at £940 from PE.&G. Hale, Coddington. All 61 bulls averaged £868.

The steer trade was fast paced with all ages in high demand whether for feeding or grazing, but credit to our vendors some real quality on offer today. Top call were a group of 11 month Angus at £1440 from Dr P.A. Shaw, Oakley; 11 month Blues at £1,330 from D.&A. Morris, Melinbarhedyn; An 8 month Piedmontese at £1,300 from Mr C. Armstrong, Church Lawton; 10 month Blues at £1,270 from GS.&A. Sheard, Stoke-on-Trent; 8 month Angus at £1,270 from J. Boulton Services, Haslington. Younger steers saw 5 month Blues from J. Badham & Son, Rugeley at £1,200 and 5 month Charolais at £1,170 from John Evans, Gnosall who also sold 5 month Charolais to £1,140 and 4 month

Blues to £1,000 from Meadow Brook Farming, Wettenhall. All 98 steers averaged £1060.

Massive numbers of heifers and plenty of demand with a super trade for all types, with best heifers selling to a premium. Top spot was £1,430 for 10 month Angus from Mr M. Clarke, Crewe; 10 month Angus at £1,360 from both L.&A. Fitton & Sons, Adbaston and Dr P.A. Shaw, Oakley; 8 month Blues at £1,335 from J. Boulton Servies, Haslington who also sold 8 month Charolais at £1,310. Younger types saw 5 month Blues at £1,100 from Mr Ian Cook, Biddulph; 4 month Charolais at £1,010 from Mr John Evans, Gnosall who also sold 5 month Blues for £990. All 194 heifers averaged £910.

Reasonable show forward and thank you for your support and confidence in the live ring, at the current junction in trade!! Trade on the day would be stronger for well fleshed and best suckler types with second and third quality still not easy to sell at this present moment and thank goodness it's a green offering the dynamic of further finishers looking to add value with certain plainer types. Weight is still a slight barrier but not just as many heavy cattle forward this week which helped and also being a green you are not tied to selling your cattle if your not happy with the trade!!

Talking points this week returned at 420p or £2,427.60 for heifers, 414p or £2,671.32 for steers and 396p or £3,477.60 for bulls. The overall market average returned at 333p or £2,042.65.
