Great to see a few more forward and rewarded with a brisker trade for all weights and grades. A real joy to sell with demand certainly outstripping supply and dare I say it many more could have been sold to vendors advantage.

Top of the shop this week returned at 320p or £2,335.12 for clean, 293p or £2,086.16 for sucklers and 293p or £2,051.10 for dairy. The overall market average returned at 232p or £1,341.52.

### 102 DAIRY YOUNGSTOCK

Auctioneers: Jonty Cliffe (07595 453306) & Jason Brown (07774 816384)

A superb entry of dairy youngstock came forward for this month's sale, with 102 head catalogued and an excellent trade throughout. The sale comprised 45 in-calf/served heifers, 44 bulling heifers and 13 weaning heifers, returning an outstanding overall average of £1,522 per head, highlighting the continued

demand for quality dairy replacements.

A tremendous consignment from Messrs Sevenoaks, Brecon opened the sale, led by the pedigree Sevenoaks Harmony Tang, due to an Aberdeen-Angus bull in September, which topped the in-calf section at £2,520. Others from the same home sold to £2,300 and £2,250. These heifers had not been heavily pushed, but buyers clearly recognised their quality and future potential. Well-grown, close-to-calving heifers from JE.&SJ. Wood, NK.&CL. Jackson and K.&JM. Jackson all met a tremendous trade, with their best selling between £2,000 and £2,400.

The bulling heifer section was arguably the strongest trade of the day, with fierce competition from buyers resulting in 17 heifers selling for over £1,400. Top price in the section was £1,600 for a smart commercial heifer from M. & D. Batkin, Marchamley. Pedigree entries from Messrs Sevenoaks and J. Lomax & Son sold consistently between £1,200 and £1,500, while a quality group of pedigree Dairy Shorthorns from WB.&BP. Norbury & Son, Sproston topped at £1,000. The sale concluded with a small offering of weanling heifers, where the best reached £550 from RC & AL Adams Ltd, Tean.

### 398 WEANLINGS

A fantastic number forward for July, and no real change in demand. The main difference this month was the type of stock on offer, with more younger weanlings and slightly less of the top-end quality we would normally expect. There was a good show of weanlings that had been grazing through the summer, with some lacking a little condition, perhaps reflecting the recent hot weather and encouraging some vendors to cash in earlier than usual. All types very good to sell with demand seeming very buoyant. Today's overall average was £837 per head.

Decent numbers of bulls but only eight over 8 months old. More demand for younger bulls than we have seen recently, as long as they were well shaped. Top spot went to a 10 month Angus from Mr S.A. Wayne, Radbourne at £1,270 who sold others at £1,150. Younger bulls included 5 month Blues at £910 from Mr S.A. Wayne; 5 month Herefords at £910 from Amy Seabridge, Stone; 7 month Friesians at £900 from Mr S.A. Wayne; 3 month Blues at £890 from GR.&E. Webster & Son, Ashbourne. All 55 bulls averaged £704.

The steer trade was fast paced with all ages in high demand, the younger they were the dearer they looked today. Top call was a 10 month Hereford at £1,480 from MD.&EK. Thesen, Goldstone; 8 month Blues from Cherry Orchard Farms, Longdon made £1,310; 7 month Blues from Mr H.G. Wright, Blakenhall sold to £1,200 and 8 month Herefords from J. Boulton Services Ltd, Haslington made £1,180. In the younger steers 5 months Blues from both NR Brandon Partnership and Mr M.A. Nicholls made £1,120, 5 month Charolais at £1,110 from Mr H.G. Wright, Blakenhall; 6 month Herefords sold for £1,010 from GS.&A. Sheard, Stoke-on-Trent. All 158 steers averaged £878.

Massive numbers of heifers and plenty of demand with a super trade for all types, with best heifers selling to

a premium but plainer grazing types looked just as dear too. Top spot was £1,220 for a 10 month Hereford from MD.&EK. Thesen, Goldstone; next were 7 month Charolais from Mr H.G. Wright at £1,210 and £1,170 and 10 month Blues from JJ.&JE. Gerrard, Winsford made £1,130. In the younger heifers we saw 6 month Blues at £1,100 from Mr M.A. Nicholls, Stafford; 5 month Blues at £955 from AJ.&MR. Hughes, Ightfield; 5 month Angus at £820 from NR Brandon Partnership; 4 month Herefords at £750 from Miss J.A. Fox, Barthomley. All 185 heifers averaged £858.

Numbers holding well for the time of year and shots of light radiating around the trade especially for handy weight clean cattle which would certainly have been better sold on the day. Averages this week would be a little bit skewed due to a large proportion of heavier cattle and overage however these also had a recalibration in price and easier placed.

The hot take on the day would be heifers to 437p or £3,109.48, steers to 428p or £2,745.16 and bulls to 391p or £3,003.48. The overall market average returned at 340p or £2,117.72.

**53 Bulls** - Few less forward and trade still a little bit "lack lustre" with leaner and plain bulls looking very well sold on the day in comparison to sucklers. Sucklers did top at 391p or £2,682.26 for a Limousin from distant supporters The Davies Family, New Mills who also saw 360p (£2,750.40). PJ.& EJ. Beechcroft & Partners, Westbury saw 370p (£2,442.00) for their Limousin and 354p (£2,421.36), FS.& MJ. Heath, Pipe Gate Limousin to 370p (£1,998.00). We did manage to breach the £3,000 mark with a Stabiliser from Julian Corfield of Corfield & Aston gross £3,003.12. Natives sold to 342p (£2,332.44) for a Hereford from Mr Simon Jones, Dimelow. Drayton specials saw black and whites to 329p (£1,816.08) from Mr Mark Gardiner, Draycott-In-The-Clay. The section average returned at 325p or £2,050.70.

**67 Steers** - Certainly a lot of weight and age about but all easily absorbed on a slighter firmer trade. Some cracking top end steers forward and these sold to 428p or £2,396.80 for Limousin from distant supporter Mr Alun Jones, Berriew and further cattle to 424p (£2,348.96), 420p (£2,268.00) and 409p (£2,503.08). L G Farms Ltd, Market Drayton corking Blue to 399p (£2,689.26) and Mr Charles Forrester, Northwood saw 390p (£2,269.80) for his Charolais. In the lump The Holdcroft Family, Audley saw their Limousins realise £2,745.16, £2,706.40 etc and Mr Darren Young, Balterley Limousin to generate £2,706.48. Natives saw Herefords to 344p (£2,125.92) from The Heeley Family, Agden. The section average returned at 340p or £2,234.99.
