Understandably a harvest entry forward and a Red Market but as always red does not mean stop with the trade as hot as the weather especially for cull cows. Few less buyers on the red but all keen to purchase cows which certainly fuelled the trade and great to see returning Arla cows back to the ring!! As always a big thank you to all our vendors and buyers for their support particularly when there is harvest work to be undertaken!!

Hot take on the day bulls to 336p or £2,571.80, sucklers to 275p or £1,914.00, dairy to 261p or £2,045.72. The overall market average returned at 232p or £1,425.27.

48 Dairies - Humble entry forward and dare I say it many more could have been sold to vendors advantage as the trade was as hot as the weather. Black and whites sold to 261p or £1,639.08 from N.&K.

Brown & Son, Admaston and 252p (£1,668.24) etc, Mr G.E. Jones, Hanmer saw 259p (£1,771.56), Mr Graham Hargreaves & Family, Cresswell cows to 257p to gross £2,045.72 and 253p (£1,948.10) and The Hockenhull Family, Willington saw 249p (£1,513.92) and 240p (£1,555.20) to mention a few. The section average returned at 210p or £1,326.27.

13 Sucklers - As always a limited number on a red with the exclusion of further feeders but what was forward found a brisk trade. Limousins to 275p or £1,914.00 from Glynn Morris & Family, Tushingham and Limousin to 256p (£1,607.68). Natives sold to 270p (£1,744.20) for a Hereford from The Jones Family, Hanmer.

18 Bulls - Dominated with restricted younger bulls and these sold to 336p or £2,540.16 from Gwyn Jones & Family, Kerry with further bulls to 334p (£2,571.80), 330p (£2,310.00), 322p (£2,251.00) etc. Natives sold to 300p (£1,956.00) for Longhorn from K. & M. Ede, Checkley. The section average returned at 279p or £1,654.18.

Cracking entry for the time of year and something for all pockets and budgets in the entry. Trade seems to be moving forward, perhaps not just as warm as the weather but certainly moving in the right direction! Handy weight cattle and full of flesh have certainly commanding a premium and many more could have been sold to vendors advantage. Large contingent of buyer support from end users to further finishers, butchers and wholesalers. A big thank you to all our vendors and buyers for their continued support and also to the team

of staff ensuring stock and clients are looked after on the hot days in a hard environment. THANK YOU!!!!

Top of the shop this week returned at 458p or £2,754.80 for heifers, 435p or £3,111.20 for steers and 390p or £3,107.00 for bulls. The overall market average returned at 343p or £2,087.42.

86 Bulls - An extremely mixed entry seeing better fleshed bulls selling on a firmer trade but lean, light types harder to place but underpinned by further finishers. Sucklers sold to 390p or £2,558.40 for a Limousin from Mr Peter Moseley & Family, Allostock who also topped the natives at 361p or £2,620.86 for Angus. Mr Tom Davies & Family, Llangedwyn saw their Limousin to 376p (£2,511.68), H.H. Hampson & Son, West Felton Limousin to 375p (£2,460.00), 359p (£2,383.76), 358p (£2,257.04) etc. Great to see Mr Richard Reynolds, Woodhouse Eaves back with Limousin to 370p (£2,057.20), 361p (£2,036.04), 360p (£2,188.80) etc. In the lump The Holdcroft Family, Audley saw their Charolais gross £3,107.00 to mention a few. Drayton specials saw black and whites to 335p (£1,594.60) for a little corker from Mr J.E. Butler, Light Oakes. The section average returned at 330p or £2,206.88 and if you took out the twenty very light black and whites this would be nearly ten pence more.

53 Steers - Certainly a lot of power in the ranks with demand throughout but heavier cattle would not just command the level of demand seen by handier weight types. Best butcher steers raced away to 435p or £2,549.10 from the returning Roberts Bros, Aberystwyth for their Limousin and further Limousin to 416p (£2,460.00) and a Blue Cross in the lump to realise £3,111.20. Closer to home we saw The Holdcroft Family, Audley selling their Limousins to 388p (£2,421.12), 378p (£2,547.72), 373p (£2,745.28), 370p (£2,471.60) and 358p (£2,348.48) Mr Darren Young, Balterley. Limousin sold to 365p to return £2,890.80 in the lump. Our Celtic connection Mr Emyr Roberts & Family, Llanfihangel saw their natives to 348p (£1,990.56). The section average returned at 340p or £2,172.25.

77 Heifers - Cracking sample in the round and very easy to sell especially butcher types seeing the superstar quality racing away to 458p or £2,445.72 for Blue Cross and last in the ring from Mr M.A. Jones, Rorrington who also saw 420p (£2,024.40) and 388p (£2,025.36). The Roberts Bros, Aberystwyth Limousins to 435p (£2,257.65) and 412p (£2,472.00). Closer to home Will & Jackie Forrester, Colehurst Limousins to 415p (£2,199.50), 406p (£2,427.88) and 388p (£2,754.80). The Holdcroft's, Audley Charolais to 394p (£2,411.28) and 386p (£2,331.44), Mr Jonny Warner, Stoke Heath Charolais to 393p (£2,090.76) and Mr Darren Young, Balterley Limousin to 389p (£2,668.54). Natives saw Welsh Blacks to 374p (£1,959.76) from Mr C.E. Bingham, Youlgrave. The section average returned at 353p or £2,038.65.

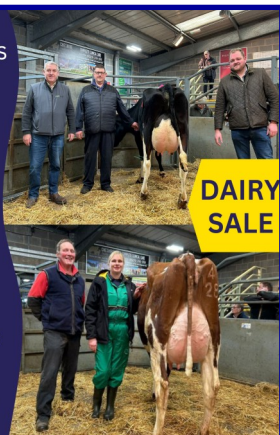
