Another reasonable show forward selling on a slightly firmer trade all through. Few more younger feeding types and sucklers in the mix commanding some spirited bidding amongst our further finishing buyers. Meated cows also a shade stronger trade with more back over the £2,000 mark which all helps in the current climate.

Summer scorcher sold to 297p or £2,105.28 for sucklers, 268p or £2,096.58 for dairy, 250p or £2,367.36 for bulls and 238p or £1,428.00 for overage clean. The overall market average returned at 204p or £1,274.83.

80 Dairies - An extremely mixed entry with cows showing signs of milking off their backs due to the weather. Trade seemed to have more spark about it throughout with meated cows looking better sold to 268p (£1,672.32) for black and white from Mr David Price & Family, Cloverley. The Martin Family, Longford presented some well fleshed Fleckvieh's selling to 249p to realise £2,096.58, 245p (£2,067.80) etc, P.A.JE. & J. Vaughan, Alvaston black and whites to 242p (£1,214.84), 240p (£1,488.00) and 238p (£1,865.92) for a Norwegian Red, J.&R. Corfield & Son, Leighton cow to 242p (£1,393.92) and Park House Dairy Ltd, Ashley cow returning 241p (£2,082.24). The entry boasted cows from 350 kilos to 844 kilos and from 88p to 268p. The section average returned at 190p or £1,144.43.

34 Sucklers - Young meated Hereford took pole position at 297p or £1,609.74 from Sandwell Metro Borough Council, West Bromwich. J.&R. Corfield & Son, Leighton Limousin to 280p (£1,685.60) and The Gosmore Family, Tattenhall Limousins to 272p (£2,105.28) and 256p (£1,894.40). R.W. Richardson & Son, Llanrhaeadr run of Limousins to 262p twice (£1,729.20 and £1,530.08) and 258p (£1,713.12) etc. Nearly all these higher prices coming from further finishers looking to value add on plainer, younger types and this is the beauty of the green. The section average returned at 244p or £1,598.39.

3 Bulls - The entry dominated with stock bulls and these sold to 250p or £2,060.00 for Limousin from Hungersheath Farm Ltd, Ashley. Angus to 230p (£1,904.40) from G. Whitfield & Son Ltd, Lilleshall and Stabiliser to 216p to gross £2,367.36 from Messrs A.G. Parrott Farming, Stafford. The section average returned at 230p or £2,110.59.

A fantastic entry for mid-August and wow, what a trade! Some weanlings were £100 dearer than our last sale, just proving the level of demand right now. The grass shortage seems to be having little impact on the trade! The ringside was packed with buyers, and whether they were looking for a small group or large numbers, they certainly made their presence known. Today's overall average was £895 per head — that's £60 up on the last sale.

A good show of 30 bulls which included a good mix of older and younger bulls to suit all budgets and they were in good demand throughout. Top spot went to 7 month Limousins at £1220 from Mr J.E. Parsons, Market Drayton who also sold a 6mo Blue bull at £1,100. A super 4 month Limousin from Mr C.J. Tams, Stafford sold for £1,080; 7 months Blues at £1,020 from Mr T.A. Williams, Stafford; 9 month Friesians at £890 from GS.&A. Sheard, Stoke-on-Trent; 4 month Angus bulls sold to £750 from Mr M.T. Jones, Leek. All bulls averaged £598 per head.

The steer trade was fast paced with all ages in high demand and up a gear on the last sale. Top spot went to a 9 month Blue at £1,290 from Richard Vernon & Partners, Hatherton; next up were a group of 7 month Blues from Redfern Farming Ltd, Stafford at £1,270; 6 month Charolais sold to £1,220 from Richard Vernon & Partners; 7 month Herefords at £1,200 from AW.&B. Titterton & Sons, Milwich who also sold 7 month Angus for £1,170. The younger types topped at £1,100 for 5 month Angus from £1,100 Richard Vernon & Partners; 5 month Blues at £1,050 from Redfern Farming Ltd. 5 month Charolais at £1,010 from Blythe Bridge Hall Farm Ltd, Stafford; 4 month Blues at £1,000 from Mr J. Moss, Stoke-on-Trent. All 145 steers averaged £919 per head.

More heifers forward, and an unbelievable trade, averaging more than the steers! But this was helped massively by the quality on offer! Top spot was £1,460 for

a 11 month Charolais from S.&S. Brian, Cresswell; 12 month Limousin at £1,310 from E.&H. Jones & Son, Shocklach who also sold 12 month Angus at £1,300. 9 month Angus at £1,270 from N.&J. Maybury, Little Hay; 11 month Blues at £1,220 from Richard Vernon & Partners; 8 month Blues at £1,200 from J. Redfern, Tamworth. Younger types saw 5 month Charolais at £1,060 from Richard Vernon & Partners; 5 month Blues at £1,060 from Mr P.L. Wood, Nantwich. All 200 heifers averaged £924 per head... unbelievable average!

Real hard work at the cliff face with a trade which seems to be in free fall. Thank goodness it's a green market with the trade under pinned with further finishers. Wholesalers and butchers all complaining about slow sales and the amount of meat coming in from Europe. I generally feel for all our vendors at present as its hard work to sell.

Pushing the charge this week we saw heifers to 400p or £2,328.80, steers to 395p or £2,599.10 and bulls to 380p or £2,728.40. The overall market average was returned at 330p or £1,907.23.

39 Bulls - Humble number forward possibly due to vendors seeing the averages else where this week and sat on the fence. Trade in parts showed signs of movement with sucklers to 380p or £2,226.80 from distant supporter Mr Chris Price, Llanfihangel and 378p (£2,593.08). Huge amount of Angus bulls forward and these topped at 359p or £2,728.40 from returning faces E.T. White & Son, Brewood and NG.&P. Sidebottom, Marple Bridge Angus also to 359p (£1,981.68). Drayton specials saw black and whites to 326p (£1,851.68) from Mr S.L. Seabridge, Sandon Bridge. The section average returned at 330p or £2,003.68.

49 Steers - An entry to boast a lot of weight in the ranks with no handy weight steers forward. Trade peaked at 395p or £2,599.10 for corking Limousin from Mr Darren Young, Balterley and 388p (£2,522.00) and Mr Charles Forrester, Northwood saw his Charolais to 368p (£2,259.52) and Mr Brian Owen, Market Drayton Blonde to 354p (£2,435.52) to mention a few. Natives to 336p (£1,881.60) for Angus from Mr G. Chidlow, Lower Heath. The section average returned at 330p or £2,115.58.

LG Farms Ltd, Market Drayton Limousin to 380p (£2,264.80) and Mr Rob Adams & Family, Stoke-On-Tern Charolais to 375p (£1,912.50) and 268p (£1,854.72) etc. In the lump Mr Bernie Parsons, Cheswardine Limousin realised £2,328.80. Natives saw Angus to 358p (£1,840.12) from Mr A.M. Jones, Rorrington. The section average returned at 330p or £1,871.71.

VENDORS RESPONSIBILITY

Ensure the following requirements are met:

- All Cows are milked on the morning of travel
- Cow produces 20 litres of milk a day or less
- No wounds, scrapes or lesions
- No dropped udder
- Not lame (Score 0)
- Body condition of above Level 2
- Max 4 hour travel time to the Market



AUCTIONS RESPONSIBILITY

- Assess lameness (Must be Score 0)
- Assess body condition (Must be above 2)
- Provide water within 9 hours
- Provide feed within 12 hours



BUYERS RESPONSIBILITY

- Direct to Slaughter or AFU
- Slaughtered using pre-stunned methods
- Limited to 4 hours single travel journey
