All cows were stale calving January through to April with several still running with the bull, probably the biggest crowd for a while at a sale of Spring calved grazing cows.

The most consistent trade was for February calving cows these generally £1,500 to £2,000 but peaking at £2,150. Top price of the day was £2,350 for a cow due with her fifth calf in March, this was followed by £2,300 for a December calving cow. In all eighteen sold £1,900 to £2,350.

Cows sold running with the bull having calved in the Spring to £1,880, £1,820 with many £1,400 plus.

A fantastic entry for the second sale of September takes us to just shy of 1,000 head for the month. Another strong trade, with the best very much on fire. It was fair to say, however, that trade for the remainder was a little easier, with the ringside slightly quieter today. Trade was "all over the place", as one buyer put it, with some looking as dear as ever, while others appeared worth a buy compared with recent trade. Nevertheless, today's overall average was still very pleasing at £819 per head.

A good show of 61 bulls, with the oldest forward being 7 months. Not as sharp as they have been but well grown bulls still right up there. Top spot went to a 7 month Hereford at £950 from Mickley Stud Ltd, Tern Hill; 6 month Blues at £870 from RW Adams & Son, Stoke-on-Tern; 5 month Herefords from RI Owen & Co, Llanbrynmair at £860 and 6 month Simmentals at £850 from Moors Covert Farm Ltd, Stafford. All bulls averaged £665 per head.

The steer trade was fast paced with all ages in high

demand. Strong well grown steers were the call of the day with 66 over £1,000. Top spot was 11 month Hereford at £1,270 from Mr S Greenhill, Congleton; 8 month Speckled Parks at £1,200 from MG&VE Hudson, Stafford; 10 month Blues at £1,180 from Mr M Groom, Eccleshall; 10 month Simmentals at £1,160 from L&D Farming, Stafford; 9 month Angus at £1,140 from GG&NA Rees, Marchwiel.

Younger heifers saw 5 month Blues at £940 from JA Fox, Barthomley; 5 month Charolais at £910 from RI Owen & Co, Llanbrynmair; and 5 month Beef Shorthorn at £850 from Mickley Stud Ltd. All 201 heifers averaged £811 per head.

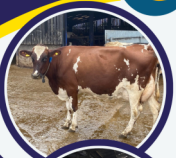
